## Tapestry

You should have received your Tapestry password activation email and you should have already logged on to see some observations showing how the children are settling into school and learning routines. If you have not been able to access your account please let us know, as you will need to use Tapestry to see your child's learning and upload homework.

## Topic

Our topic this term will be 'My World, Our World.' We will be learning about ourselves as individuals, our families, being part of the school community, the wider area and celebrating diversity.

## PE

The children will do PE on Monday afternoons with the sports coach Mrs. Pollard. They will change into their PE kit at school and put their school uniform into their PE bag to bring home at the end of the day. ## Homework

Homework will be set at the parent meeting every Monday afternoon at 3.05pm and will also be uploaded to the 'Class information' Tapestry account. This will start on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September. Please come into your child's classroom at 3.05pm. Please ensure that you upload your child's response to the homework via an observation on their individual Tapestry account. This can be in the form of a written observation, a photo or a video. We will monitor and mark homework by writing a comment.

## Reading

Your child will receive their first reading book on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> September. Please keep this inside their Planner and bring it to school every day. After you have read the book 3 times and signed the Planner please change your child's reading book by putting it into their folder in the EYFS entrance. Then take the next book out of their folder to read at home.

Please ensure that your child brings a jumper or cardigan, a coat, a bottle of water and their bookbag with their reading planner and any books we have given you every day. Please ensure everything is named.
