I hope you have had a wonderful summer holiday and made some special memories. We are so looking forward to seeing the children on Monday morning and hearing all about them.

Here are a few reminders :-

In the morning the gates will open at 8:45am and registers will close at 9:00am.

Children will enter the school building as they did last year.

Reception and Years 3 and 4 through the carpark to the right of the building.

Years 5 and 6 to the left of the building and then through the side entrance.

Key Stage One through the left side gate and round to their classroom doors.

There will be staff around on Monday to help direct you.

Please note under Covid guidelines parents will still not be able to enter the school building.

3:15pm

At the end of the day Reception will be brought to the door and parents will wait in the line marked on the playground until the teachers hand over their children.

All other parents will enter school via the side gate to the left of the main entrance.

Key Stage one will leave via their classroom doors.

We will then still operate the same one way system as we did last year with

parents leaving via the car park gate. Again there will be staff around to help you at the end of the day.

3:20pm

Years 3 and 4 will be brought into the playground at the back of the school and will be dismissed in classes. Teachers will show you where parents will need to stand.

Year 5 and 6 will be brought out the side entrance and to the front of the school building.

Please fill in the form sent home by the school office if your child in Years 5 and 6 are walking home on their own.

Children will return to eating in the hall. Lunches will be staggered across these times for individual classes.
